

Trip Around the World Quilt, Child

This kit includes 63 – 6” squares of eight different fabrics. Backing fabric may also be included. The finished size of this quilt is approximately 38½” x 49½”.

*Fabric requirements: Blocks – 8 different fabrics from a 6” square for the center, to a 12” length [42” wide]

Backing – 1 ½ yards x 42” wide









Batting – 41” x 52”

*Cutting instructions: Cut each fabric into 6” wide strips. Cut strips into 6” squares according to the Cutting Chart.

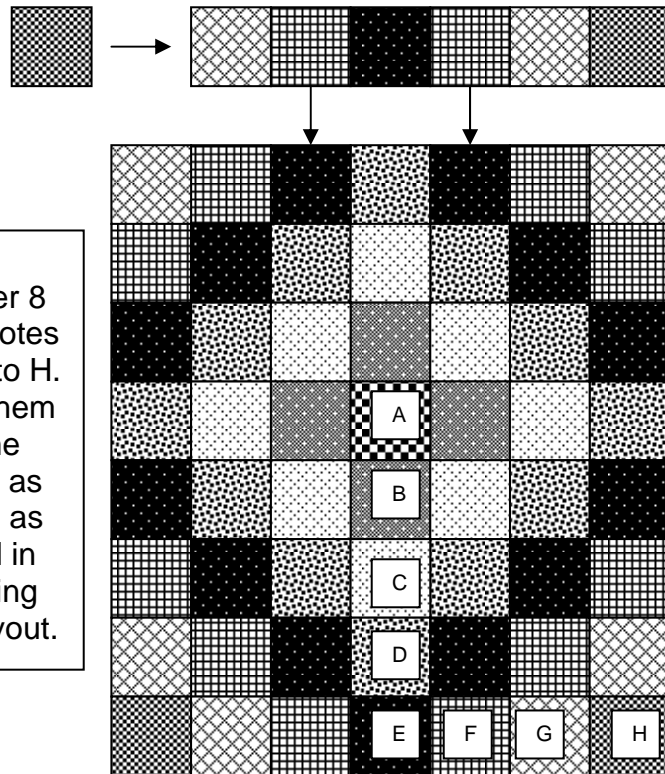
Using a ¼” seam allowance throughout, sew the squares together into rows of 7 squares across according to the picture of the finished quilt. Sew the rows together.

Suggestion: Lay squares out on table or floor to check placement.

CUTTING CHART

	A	1 square
	B	4 squares
	C	8 squares
	D	12 squares
	E	14 squares
	F	12 squares
	G	8 squares
	H	4 squares

Tip:
Number 8 sticky notes from A to H. Place them on the blocks as shown as an aid in following your layout.



This blanket can be finished using the traditional method, which uses a binding, or the ‘envelope’ method, which uses no binding. Quilt or tie at least every 3 ½ to 4 inches. Quilting in the ditch looks nice and reinforces the blanket. Quilting ½” around the outside edges gives a more finished look when using the ‘envelope’ method.

*Fabric requirements and cutting instructions are included for those wishing to make this pattern at home.
