## Illinois Roads Quilt, Child

Fabric A - $3 / 4$ yard
Fabric B - $3 / 4$ yard
Fabric C $-5 / 8$ yard theme fabric
Backing - $11 / 2$ yards
Batting - 41" $\times 53$ "

From Fabric A: cut four 2" wide strips for inner border and cut six 2" wide strips for fabric A of Block 1

From Fabric B: cut four $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide strips for outer border and cut six 2" wide strips for fabric B of Block 1

From Fabric C: cut $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide strips, then cut strips into $61 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ " squares for Block 2.

Using a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance throughout, sew fabric strips A to fabric strips B. Press the seams. Cut these two-color strips into units that are $31 / 2$ " squares.


Sew 4 of these square units into larger units as shown at right to form Block 1.

 Theme fabric

Using the squares of theme fabric C as Block 2, sew rows of 5 blocks, alternating Blocks 1 and 2. Make four of Row 1 and three of Row 2.

Row 1


Row 2


Sew rows together alternating Row 1 and Row 2 to form the rectangular center of the quilt.

Sew Border A strips to left and right sides. Press and trim. Sew Border A (narrow) strips to top and bottom. Press and trim.

Repeat process with Border B (wider) strips, sewing sides first, then top and bottom.


Layer and quilt as desired.

Finished size is approximately 39 " x 51"
