

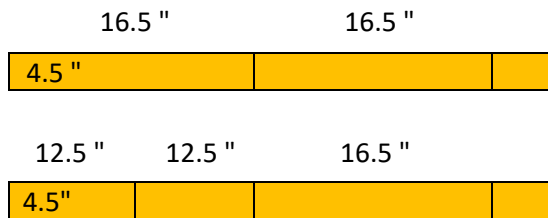
Join AQQ at the 2019 Quilt Show as we Build-A-Quilt for boys. We are partnering with AZ Blankets 4 Kids and Mulqueens Sewing and Fabric Centers to create warm, comfortable quilts for boys of all ages. AZ Blankets 4 Kids will distribute the quilts to seriously ill and traumatized children in the Phoenix area.

Anyone participating in the project will earn a ticket or tickets (depending on your level of participation) for a new sewing machine donated by Mulqueens! For those who bring finished projects to the show, you will earn one ticket for one complete block, 15 for a complete top and 25 for a finished quilt. Tickets also will be given to people who stop by our booth near Mulqueens and sew or quilt. Mulqueens is providing sewing machines and dedicating a long arm to our efforts!

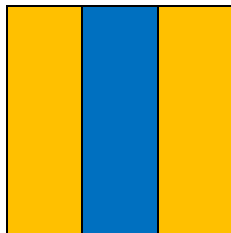
Our pattern, created by Kathy O'Brien, requires 12 blocks using (preferably) 12 different fabrics. Strips are cut to 4.5" by WOF. Two of these strips make one block. The finished quilt measures 48"x72".

Build-A-Quilt Pattern and Instructions

1. One block measures 12.5" x 24.5". To complete two blocks, use two coordinating fabrics. From each fabric, cut two 4.5" inch strips. Sub-cut strips into three 16.5" lengths and two 12.5" lengths.



2. Sew 16.5" strips together with coordinating fabric in center.



3. Sew 12.5" strips to each end to complete your block.



4. Sew 12 blocks together as shown in diagram below to complete one quilt.
