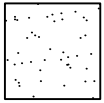
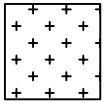


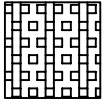
Dinosaur Quilt - Child Size



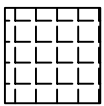
BACKGROUND - $1 \frac{1}{8}$ Yards
Cut:
38 Squares - $5 \frac{1}{2}$ "
5 Squares for Triangles - $5 \frac{7}{8}$ "



BACKGROUND ACCENT - $\frac{1}{4}$ Yards
Cut:
6 Squares - $5 \frac{1}{2}$ "



BODY - 1 Yard
Cut:
23 Squares - $5 \frac{1}{2}$ "
5 Squares for Triangles - $5 \frac{7}{8}$ "



SPINES - $\frac{1}{4}$ Yard
Cut:
4 Squares for Triangles - $5 \frac{7}{8}$ "



EYE - Cut:
Approx. $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " Square

BACKING - 42" x 53"

BATTING - 42" x 53"

BINDING - (5) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " Strips - $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric

Hint: Cut Fabric Squares for Triangles First

Half Square Triangle Blocks Combinations

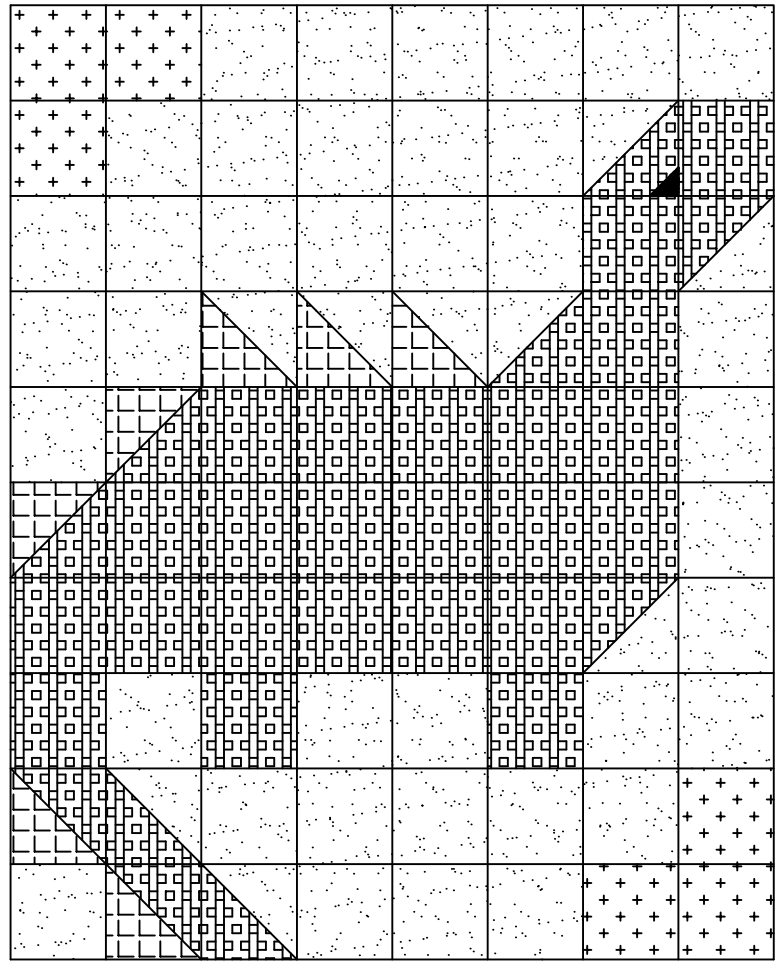
- Sew together 3 Background Squares with 3 Body Squares (makes 6 blocks)
- Sew together 2 Body Squares with 2 Spine Squares (makes 4 blocks)
- Sew Together 2 Background Squares with 2 Spine Squares (Makes 4 blocks)

Half Square Triangle Construction

Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other on reverse side of lightest fabric. Place two fabric squares right sides together. Sew a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on each side of center line. Cut along center line. This produces 2 blocks.

Eye Construction

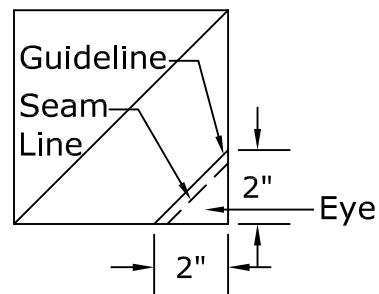
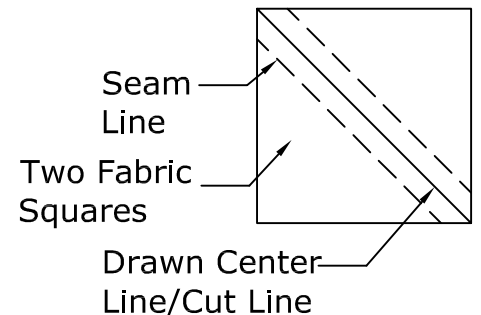
Draw diagonal guideline starting 2" up from sides of body portion of body/background block. Place eye fabric and body fabric right sides together with the bulk of the eye fabric towards center of block. Sew seam $\frac{1}{4}$ " from guideline on corner side. Trim seam $\frac{1}{4}$ " and trim sides to square up block.



Finished Quilt Size Is Approximately 40" x 50"
Fabric Quantities based on 42" Wide Fabric

General Instructions

Sew half square triangle blocks. Sew block with eye. Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance throughout, sew rows with 8 blocks each. Sew 10 rows together.
