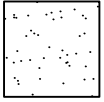


# Dog and Bone Quilt - Child Size

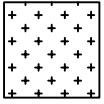


BACKGROUND -  $1 \frac{1}{4}$  Yards

Cut:

42 Squares -  $5 \frac{1}{2}$ "

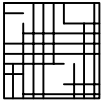
2 Squares for Triangles -  $5 \frac{7}{8}$ "



BACKGROUND ACCENT -  $\frac{1}{2}$  Yard

Cut:

12 Squares -  $5 \frac{1}{2}$ "



BODY -  $\frac{1}{2}$  Yard

Cut:

16 Squares -  $5 \frac{1}{2}$ "

1 Square for Triangles -  $5 \frac{7}{8}$ "



BONE -  $\frac{1}{4}$  Yard

Cut:

6 Squares -  $5 \frac{1}{2}$ "

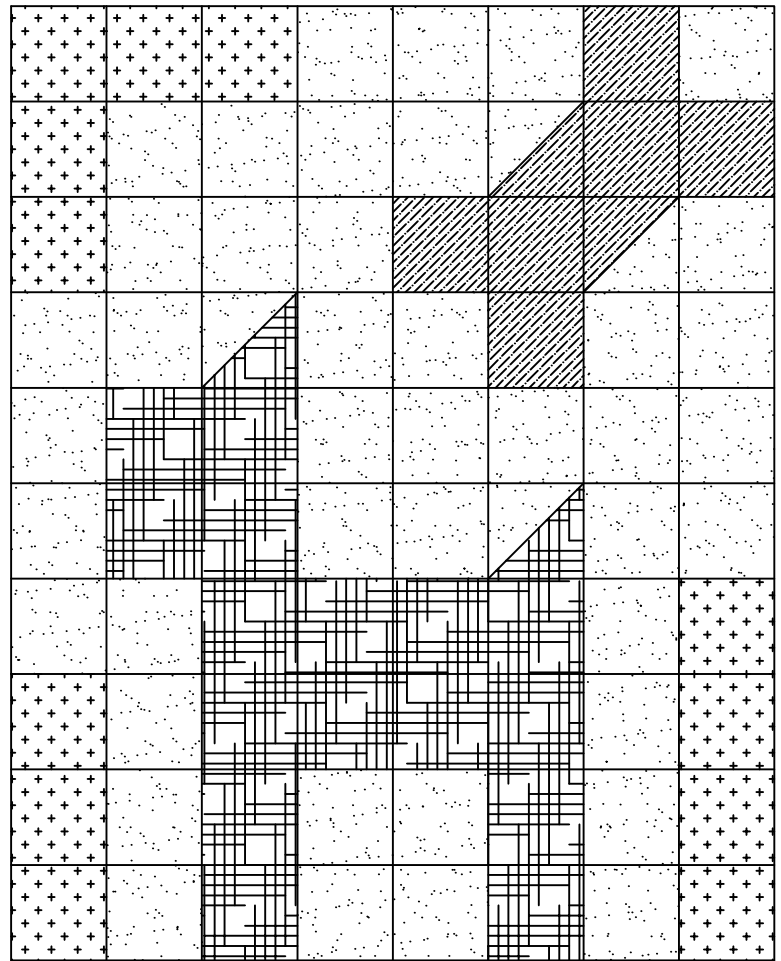
1 Square for Triangles -  $5 \frac{7}{8}$ "

BACKING - 42" x 53"

BATTING - 42" x 53"

BINDING - (5)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " Strips -  $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric

Hint: Cut Fabric Squares for Triangles First



Finished Quilt Size Is Approximately 40" x 50"  
Fabric Quantities based on 42" Wide Fabric

## General Instructions

Sew half square triangle blocks. Using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance throughout, sew rows with 8 blocks each. Sew 10 rows together.

## Half Square Triangle Blocks Combinations

- Sew together 1 Background Square with 1 Body Square (makes 2 blocks)
- Sew together 1 Background Square with 1 Bone Square (makes 2 blocks)

## Half Square Triangle Construction

Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other on reverse side of lightest fabric. Place two fabric squares right sides together. Sew a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam on each side of center line. Cut along center line. This produces 2 blocks.
